TDHHC has been developing working relationships with many different entities in order to provide interpreting services. We have seen a large increase in the volume of services provided for the Deaf/HH Community.

This year TDHHC, the Advisory Committee, and ETDA are bringing back Deaf Awareness Week and KissFist. So be looking for more information coming soon. One of the most exciting changes that TDHHC has made is meeting and exceeding the needs for interpreting requests. We have started an internal mentoring program with pre-certified Interpreters who are now contracted with TDHHC. TDHHC is developing an environment for our pre-certified interpreters to have real-life experience and improve their skills as they are working towards their certification.

Over the past year, we have been working on improving TDHHC's working relationship with TJC and their Interpreter Training Program (ITP) with the Dean, Department Chair, faculty, and students. The focus is to put in place a mentoring program to help the student become involved in the Deaf/HH community before they graduate; enter into the interpreter's world and provide an easy transition into the interpreting field.

In spite of these crazy and exciting times, the one thing that will never change is our core purpose, to ensure that the needs of the Deaf/HH in East Texas are met with quality, skilled and certified professional interpreters whose hearts and desires are to be involved in the Deaf/HH Community.


Bronchos and was one of the key pitchers on the Giants' National League championship teams of 1904 and 1905.
